Department of Commerce Minority/Female Management Internship Program 1988-1990

The Department of Commerce is offering two-year internships, beginning in June 1988 to at least four exceptionally well-qualified female and minority graduates attending Virginia colleges and universities, or Virginia students attending out-of-state colleges and universities. Interns will be assigned to various divisions within the Department of Commerce, work ing in a number of occupational disciplines.
