

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Faculty Senate At its May 8th Meeting, the Faculty Senate voted favorably on the following matters:

1. Resolved:

that six hours (one sequence) of foreign language be required for all candidates for the B.S. degrees and professional degrees. This requirement will be effective with the fall, 1990, college catalog.

The Senate further directs the Curriculum Committee of the Faculty to consider and adopt processes for the implementation of the above resolution during the course of the 1989-1990 academic year with all such work to be completed before May 1 of 1990.

2. Resolved:

that a general education study committee be recommended to the President to be established during the 1989-1990 academic year. The committee would consist of three full professors with one course release time each for the fall semester to conduct a study and make recommendations to the Curriculum Committee on the restructuring of the general education requirements of the College. The General Education Study Committee shall make its recommendations to the Curriculum Committee in timely fashion and on a regular basis during the 1989-1990 academic year, so that its work can be validated by the Faculty Senate and presented to the administration for consideration and action in time for the publication of the 1990-1991 academic catalog.
