Paychecks Procedures for Early Receipt of Paychecks for Individuals Who Have Requested Permission to Pick Up Their Paychecks Directly from the Personnel Office

> Individuals who will not be on campus on payday may be given their paychecks on the workday preceding payday after 3:00 p.m. only if they meet the following conditions:

> Faculty - Faculty members, either Instructional or Administrative, may receive their paycheck between 3:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. on the workday preceding payday by executing the standard Certificate.

> Classified Employees - Classified employees may receive their paychecks between 3:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m. on the workday preceding payday by presenting an approved Leave Form and by signing the standard Certificate.

> Wage Employees - Wage employees may receive their paychecks between 3:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m. on the workday preceding payday by presenting a signed statement from their supervisor that they will not be working the following workday, "payday, and by signing the standard Certificate.


