## Budget Reports

Financial accounting system users are hereby informed that technical difficulties have been encountered in start up for fiscal year 1982-1983. Regular reports for the month of July may not be produced. The first AMO91 report distributed should be examined carefully and should contain complete listings of transactions, year to-date. Users are also advised that budget entries reflected on the end of August reports will occur only as a result of functioning of the automatic budget reallocation system. Departmental budgets will not be entered into the accounting system until the 5% reduction of budget directed by Governor Robb has taken place and final working budgets have been developed and reconciled.
