DEAN'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

Merit Salary Increases

Several inquiries have been received concerning the procedures that will be followed in arriving at the decision as to which faculty members will be awarded a merit salary increase. The following paragraph excerpted from the Faculty Handbook (page V-21) addresses this matter:

"In identifying those members of the faculty who have rendered exceptional service to the College, the Dean of Academic Affairs will consult with the Assistant Deans of Academic Affairs, the Vice-Chairman of the Faculty, and the Chairman of the Faculty Advisory Committee before making his recommendation to the President."

The Faculty Personnel Committee neither makes recommendations nor considers recommendations for merit pay. Recommendations for merit pay increases from peer groups are welcomed; however, this is not a requirement since all faculty members will be considered in reaching the final decision as to whom will be recognized by a merit increase of salary for exceptional service to the College.

Faculty Development Grants

On February 22, the FAC will review the Faculty Development Grant applications submitted during the period January 16 - February 17 and make its recommendations to Dean Edwards. Cross Registration Procedures

In the fall, the proposed procedures for Undergraduate Student Cross Registration Procedures for the Virginia Tidewater Consortium were returned to FAC by the Faculty with a request for additional information. The FAC has met with Mr. Larry Dotolo, the Director of the Tidewater Consortium to clarify our understanding of these guidelines and procedures. We learned that these procedures which we were told were final in the fall have undergone additional modification.

Upon receipt of the absolutely final version of the procedures, FAC will develop specific CNC guidelines for implementation and bring both the broad and specific policies to the Faculty for its consideration. Mr. Dololo will be invited to the faculty meeting to provide precise answers to any particular concern of the Faculty.
