\* CORRECTION: Yesterday's note concerning the "lost call" transferring syndrome needs to be revised. Our phone system has been set up so that the transfer of calls need not go through the switchboard. Recently, we had some difficulty with the system, but that problem seems to be solved.

\* The correct procedure for transferring incoming calls is as follows:

\* Depress receiver button firmly for about one second and release it. When dial tone is heard, the incoming party is automatically placed on "Hold." Dial the 3 digit extension number. When extension answers announce call and hang up. If busy, depress receiver button again and inform caller.

\* It might be helpful to be sure that the incoming party knows the new extension number. Then, if he is disconnected, he can call the College again and ask for the correct number.
