Interim Report on the Tenure and Workload Study

This announcement is in response to several questions posed recently concerning the status of the Tenure and Workload Study and the data being processed by State Council relative to the study.

The State Council is behind in their implementation schedule for the project. Data was provided to Christopher Newport which finally permitted the submission of the report to State Council during the early part of the Christmas holidays. The State Council has indicated to me that they are now ready to provide an interim report to the College and will provide a mechanism for updating the report.

It is now appropriate for you to review your individual census data being sent to State Council if you wish to do so. The data is on file at the Office of Institutional Research and contains the following elements:
