Fulbright Teacher Exchange Program

Applications are now being accepted for the Fulbright Teacher Exchange Program for the 1989-1990 academic year. The program is open to college instructors, assistant, associate and full professors currently employed with three years full-time teaching experience (two years for seminar offerings). Language fluency is required for some non-English speaking countries; U.S. citizenship is required.

There are opportunities for one-year direct exchange of positions with teachers from abroad as well as opportunities for attending summer seminars abroad.

Placements are available in Argentina, Australia, Belgium/Luxembourg, Brazil, Canada, Colombia, Chile, Cyprus, Denmark, the Federal Republic of Germany, Finland, France, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Mexico, The Netherlands, Norway, Panama, the Philippines, Senegal, South Africa, Switzerland, and the United Kingdom.

Applications are distributed in August and September; the application deadline is October 15, 1988.

The Faculty Senate extends an invitation to all members of the College Community who wish to attend the Senate meetings.


