### Dean, School of Business and Economics

Christopher Newport College invites applications for the position of dean of the School of Business and Economics. Candidates should be prepared to integrate the School into the business community of the Commonwealth, to broaden its growing emphasis on an international perspective, and to work closely with its 27 full-time faculty and with the rest of the academic community of the College in shaping the future of the School.

The successful candidate will hold a terminal degree in one of the seven disciplines in which the School offers degrees (accounting, economics, finance, international culture and commerce, management, marketing, and real estate), will have completed at least five years of teaching at the college level, and will show evidence of responsible administrative experience. As one of the key ambassadors of the College to the business community, the successful candidate should show promise of effectiveness in the areas of human relations, public service, and fund-raising.

The person selected must qualify for appointment to the senior ranks of the faculty in one of the academic departments of the School. Academic rank and salary will be commensurate with qualifications.
