Curriculum Committee Meetings

March 15, 1984 & April 15, 1984

It was reported in the March 15th meeting that the VPAA and College deans will look to the Department of Computer Science for the initiative in changes to the structure of courses in their area. The Department had brought proposed changes to our Committee at the February 23, 1984 meeting, but the BSIS curriculum matter was tabled at that time. It is expected that Computer Science representation will visit with the Curriculum Committee during the fourth week in April to further discuss.

The balance of our meeting was devoted as to how best be involved in a "new curriculum" review process covering the proposal brought to the Committee by the Ad Hoc Curriculum Task Force. It is planned that beginning in mid-April, portions of the Curriculum Committee will meet with each of the three Schools to record comments of omission, correction, or general concern. It is planned that our Committee will then coordinate a revised (if necessary) proposal representing the sentiment of the entire faculty, and bring this proposal to a faculty meeting next fall.

In the Committee's April 5, 1984 meeting only announcements were made relevant to the upcoming reviews by all Schools on the revised curriculum.

The College does not currently have any policy by which a student may be denied admission to the College for any reasons other than academic. It is felt by the Admissions Committee that applicants who have had documented behavior problems at this or any other institution may pose a risk to other students, administration, staff and faculty. Research presented by the Dean of Admissions and Records indicates that such policy does exist at most other colleges and universities.

Therefore, the Admissions Committee recommends the following admissions policy statement be approved by the faculty for inclusion in the next printing of the CNC Catalogue.

"A new or readmission applicant who has been suspended or placed on probation from this or any other institution for non-academic, social, or disciplinary reasons may be denied admission to the College."
